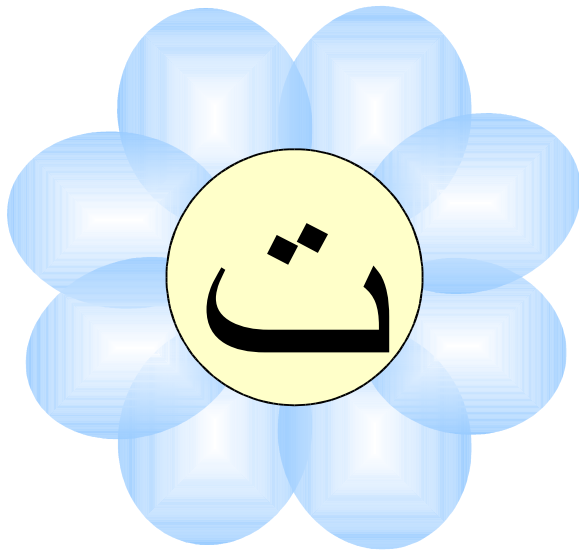


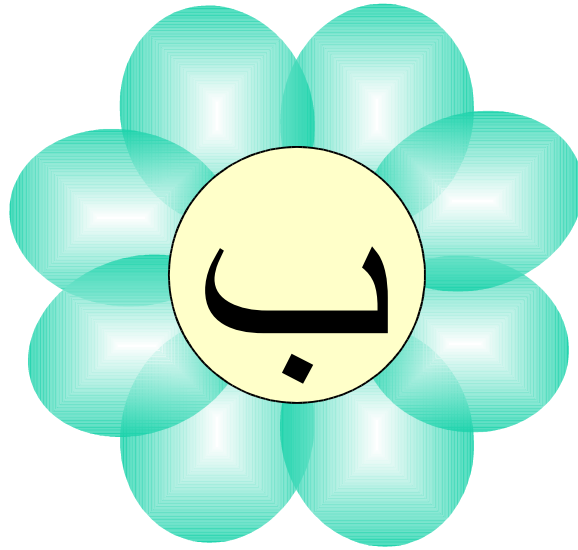
Arabic Alphabet Matching Game

HOW TO USE THIS FILE:

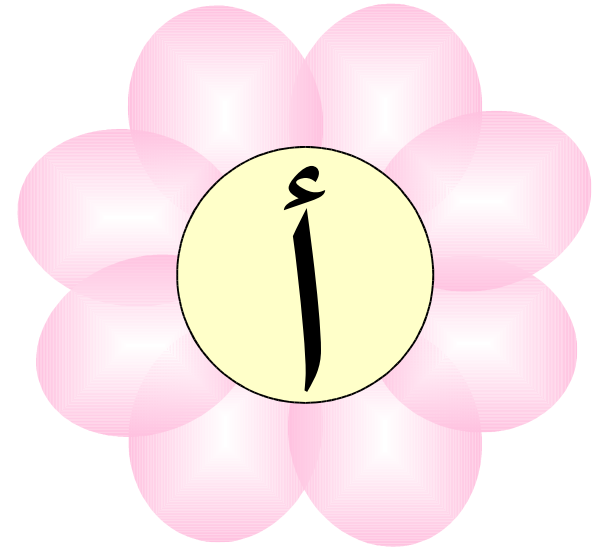
- ❖ Print all pages twice. I preferred to print the pages on cardstock and then laminated them prior to cutting out the pieces. For those of you who do not have a color printer – remember that Kinko's (in the US) has facilities where you can use their computer and print off documents in color for a fee.
- ❖ Cut out all the pieces (along the lines) of the Arabic Memory Sheets.
- ❖ Use these sheets for a matching game. Simply lay down all the cards face down (I usually take about eight different letters with their matches at a time – you can use more for an older child). Have your child turn over (one at a time) two cards each time. If they find a pair, set them aside. If not, turn the cards over again and pick another two cards. Your child must try to find the pairs of each Arabic letter. To improve recognition of the Arabic alphabet, tell your child what letter has been turned over each time.
- ❖ You can also just print out each page once, and use the materials as flashcards.



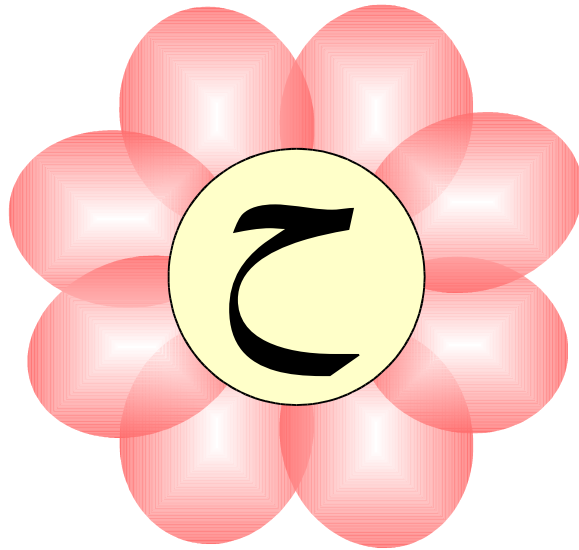
